Where analytics cookies are used, you will be given the opportunity to accept or decline them through our cookie settings.

Third-party services

Our website is hosted by Wix.

Some cookies may be placed by Wix or other trusted third-party services that help deliver the functionality of the website.

Where third-party cookies are used, they will only be used for legitimate website functionality or analytics.
